This year Barbara helped pass a law limiting school children's bus times on new school bus routes. It mandates that bus rides be no longer than 30 minutes, with an allowance of 45 minutes possible for certain specific criteria.

Although it is limited to younger kids -- kindergarten to fifth grade, Barbara hopes to expand it to more ages.

Barbara believes it is pretty hard to be in the junior class play, be on the football team or edit the yearbook when a student spends four hours on the road, just to get to and from school.

By riding up to two hours each way, rural and lower income school children are deprived of extra-curricular opportunities that would improve their chances for higher education.

We can count on Barbara to keep fighting to expand this law.



Delgate Fleischauer: Helping Victims of Abuse

Delegate Fleischauer helped start the Monongalia County Child Advocacy Center, which coordinates services for children involved in abuse and neglect cases.

There are approximately 900 allegations of child abuse or neglect every year in our county.

The Center provides a safe, child-friendly setting where children can be interviewed in one location by the professionals who must decide if further investigation or treatments are needed.

Barbara Fleischauer strongly believes all West Virginians deserve access to quality, affordable health care. While the debate rages on this issue, Barbara was successful in securing increased coverage for our children's health care coverage. We can count on Delegate Fleischauer to continue fighting for us on this issue while protecting and expanding programs such as CHIPS.

Barbara fought hard to pass the Oral Health Bill which mandated the Department of Health & Human Services to establish a separate office for dental care.
